

# PRESS RELEASE

The Trinidad and Tobago Racing Authority hereby advises of decisions taken at its meeting held on Tuesday 20 October, 2009.

(1) CONTINUATION OF THE ENQUIRY INTO THE ALLEGED INHUMANE MANNER IN WHICH RACEHORSE AUDACIOUS WAS EUTHANISED ON JUNE 29, 2009

Mr. Randolph Williams - Groom :

The Board having heard from Mr. Randolph Williams - Groom licence #915 and numerous other witnesses over the course of the enquiry found him to be guilty of a breach of Rule 69 (3) of the Rules of Racing.

As such, the Board agreed that in accordance with Rule 7 (4) (q) of the Rules of Racing, declared him to be warned-off and therefore a disqualified person with effect from Wednesday 28 October 2009 for a period of five (5) years.

During the period of his disqualification, Mr. Williams' will be debarred from entering any restricted area (Stables, Weighing Room, Saddling Enclosure, etc) on racecourse premises here or elsewhere.

Mr. Harrylal Harry - Groom:

The Board noted that this was the second consecutive occasion Mr. Harrylal Harry - Groom #37 failed to attend the enquiry, and as such has decided in accordance with Rule 7(4) (o) to suspend Mr. Harry's Groom licence with immediate effect until such time as he appeared before the Board in the matter.

(2) CONSIDERATION OF AN APPLICATION BY MR. TIMOTHY MURRAY FOR RENEWAL OF HIS JOCKEY'S LICENCE

The Board after careful consideration and deliberation agreed to the renewal of Mr. Murray's Jockey licence. Mr. Murray was Champion Apprentice with 40 Wins in 1983 and last rode in 1985.
