

# MEDIA RELEASE

The Board of the Authority hereby advises of decision taken at its meeting held on **Tuesday July 2 2013.**

1. **Enquiry into the finding of Prohibited Substances 'PHENYLBUTAZONE and OXYPHENBUTAZONE', in the sample of equine urine and blood No. 525570 taken from 'ANGELICA JANE (BAR)', unplaced in Race 1 / Day 35 of the 2012 Racing Season held on Saturday October 06, 2012**

Having given due consideration to the evidence of Mr. Harold Chadee Trainer of 'ANGELICA JANE (BAR)', and that of Mr. David Ramkhalawan Groom, the Board found Mr. Chadee to be in breach of Rule Nos. 62 (8), 63 (1) and 102 (1) (d) of the Rules of Racing. Therefore, pursuant to Rule Nos: 62 (8) 100 (B) (4) of the Rules of Racing, the Board has decided to suspend him for a period of one month with effect from July 09, 2013, fine him the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and further in accordance with Rule Nos. 7 (4) (q) and 63 (1) declare him a disqualified person for the period stated above.

During the period of his disqualification, he will be debarred from entering any racecourse premises here or elsewhere.

2. **HEARING OF AN APPEAL LODGED BY DR. EDWARD COMMISSIONG OWNER OF SEA STORM THE 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE FINISHER IN RACE 3 / DAY 33 – SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 15, 2012 AGAINST THE DECISION OF THE STEWARDS NOT TO DISQUALIFY THE 2<sup>ND</sup> PLACED FINISHER BE PRECISE .**

Having given due consideration to the grounds of his appeal, and evidence at the hearing including that of Mr. Richard Freeman, Steward of the Club, Apprentice Jockey Kerron Khelawan rider of SEA STORM, Apprentice Jockey Nigel Flavenney rider of BE PRECISE and Trainer Mr. Anthony Serville. The Authority noted, and was satisfied that there was no justification to take any further action in the matter. Accordingly, the appeal was disallowed and decision stands.

3. **HEARING OF AN APPEAL LODGED BY STEPHEN JARDIM TRAINER AGAINST THE DECISION F THE STEWARDS TO FINE HIM \$200.00 FOR FAILING TO REPORT TO THEM – SATURDAY MAY 18, 2012.**

Having given due consideration to the grounds of his appeal, and evidence at the hearing including that of Mr. Richard Halfhide, Steward of the Club, the Authority noted and was satisfied that the Stewards acted with their powers under the Rules of Racing, and there was no justification to take any further action in the matter. Accordingly, the appeal was disallowed and decision stands.

4. **HEARING OF AN APPEAL LODGED BY DOUGLAS BENNETT TRAINER OF CONVOY (6<sup>TH</sup>) AGAINST THE DECISION OF THE STEWARDS NOT TO DISQUALIFY HEIDI'S TZIPPI FROM 2<sup>ND</sup> PLACE IN RACE 6 OF FRIDAY MAY 31, 2013.**

Having given due consideration to the grounds of his appeal, and evidence at the hearing including that of Mr. Richard Freeman, Steward of the Club, Jockey Nicholas Patrick rider of CONVOY and Apprentice Kerron Khelawan rider of HEIDI'S TZIPPI. The Authority noted, and was satisfied that there was no justification to take any further action in this matter. Accordingly, the appeal was disallowed and decision stands.
