NOTICE

TO: ALL PRIVATE VETERINARIANS
FROM: THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY
DATE: DECEMBER 15, 2022
RE: LICENSING OF PRIVATE VETS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2023

Further to the notice dated October 7th, 2022 on the subject matter (*see copy attached*), this serves as a gentle reminder that the licensing of Practicing (Private) Veterinarians would become **effective on January 1st, 2023**.

Pursuant to Rule 101 (4) of the Rules of Racing -

“Practicing Veterinarians shall not participate in racing under the jurisdiction of the Authority, without a valid license issued by the Authority.

A. Eligibility

An applicant for a license as practicing veterinarian shall be qualified and licensed to practice veterinary medicine in this jurisdiction and be otherwise qualified to be issued a license to participate in racing. An application for a practicing veterinarian license from the Authority must be accompanied by the original and a copy of the applicant's current license to practice veterinary medicine in Trinidad and Tobago; additionally, a fee (as determined by the Authority) shall be paid at the time such an application is lodged, which shall be refunded if the application is refused.”

The relevant forms to facilitate this process will be made available on January 1, 2023.

Please be guided accordingly.
